The proposed Khmer Extended block includes lunar date symbols that are used with Khmer. The proposed range is U+19E0 – U+19FF.

Sorting order – The sorting order of the Khmer Extended block should be in the order of the Unicode characters.

Typographical form of Khmer lunar dates – The typographical form of Khmer lunar dates is a top and bottom section of the same size text. The dividing line between the upper and lower half of the symbol is the vertical center of the line height.

Compatibility mapping – These considered as atomic units. Creating compatibility mappings would make sorting more difficult. Numbers are sometimes superscript and sometimes subscript.
